

Adult

Wingspan: 9 to 11 cm
Duration: about 3 to 5 weeks
or 8 months (migratory generation)

Male

- Males have black spots (called androconial patches) on their hind wings.

Female

- Wider black veins than males.
- When laying her eggs, the female bends almost in half, pointing the tip of her abdomen toward the underside of the leaf.
